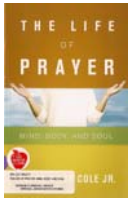


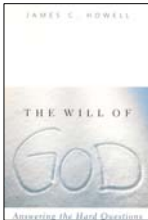

By Allan Hugh Cole Jr. Westminster John Knox Press, 2009

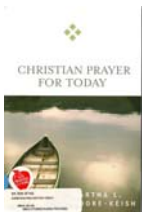

By James C. Howell, Westminster John Knox Press, 2009

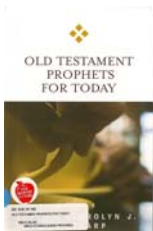

By Carolyn J. Sharp, Westminster John Knox Press, 2009.

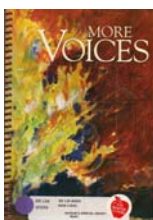
Offers a brief introduction to each of the Bible's OT prophets, illuminating themes present in each, with an eye toward the many ways in which their messages remain relevant today.

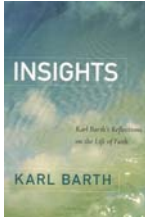
A diverse group of pastors and preachers respond to Carl's question: What is your best advice to colleagues in ministry about preaching and being a pastor?

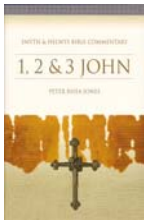
Explores the process of crafting effective sermons and gathers strategies of good writers. Provides examples, exercises, and reflections.
