

# Hunger Bits

**We give gladly to help with hunger relief in many ways. Here are some of the programs we support through our contributions.**

***Church World Service*** has many faces. A very familiar one was seen immediately after the Asian tsunamis struck in December 2004. CWS responds to disasters in a wholistic manner. They were on-site hours after the disaster, but they are committed to stand with the people during recovery and rehabilitation. When the images of disaster fade from our television screens, CWS is there with medical care, rebuilding homes and schools, and strengthening food security.

***Churchville Community Food Pantry*** receives a large amount of assistance from the Loch Willow Presbyterian Church. In addition, six local churches participate in this community effort that has been a sustaining force in the community for five years. Each month 40-50 families representing 100-150 individuals of ages receive food here. Contributions of time, effort, money and prayer all come together in response to Jesus' command, "you give them something to eat."

***Kingsway Help Center*** located in Steeles Tavern, Va., keeps very busy serving their community. Their wholistic ministry provided food in 2004 to 1,644 families, or 4,646 people. Providing food is an essential part of this ministry where people also receive clothing, home assistance and books for so many children. The people they serve consist of mostly disabled people, single parent families, large families without adequate income and the elderly.

***Jefferson County Community Ministries*** is located in Charles Town, West Virginia. It's a cooperative ministry of local churches in Jefferson County to assist people in need. The Food Pantry distributes food to those referred by the JCCM office. The pantry receives donations of food and money which are given to those they serve. The pantry is open Monday through Friday from 9am-12noon, and is staffed by volunteers from participating community churches.

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
